For the **purpose of verifying legal capacity** the date of birth is required. The basis in law for this is article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 b) DS-GVO.

For the **purpose of internal communication**, the address, the mail address and the phone number are required. The basis in law for this is article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 b) DS-GVO.
